Your Symptoms:

- ▶ Sprains, strains and minor fractures
- ▶ Cold or flu symptoms
- ▶ Skin rashes, infections, or minor wounds
- ▶ Nausea, vomiting, or abdominal discomfort
- ▶ Urinary tract infections
- ▶ Minor eye injuries, infections, or irritation
- ▶ Insect bites or stings
- ▶ Ear pain or sore throat

Your Symptoms:

- ▶ **Heart attack symptoms:** chest pain, shortness of breath, dizziness, arm or jaw pain
- ▶ **Stroke symptoms:** severe headache, weakness, confusion, slurred speech
- ▶ Head injury with loss of consciousness or while on blood thinners
- ▶ Infants under 12 weeks with fever
- ▶ Complications of pregnancy
- ▶ Severe allergic reactions
