Radiofrequency Ablation Pre and Post-Care Instructions

As you are required to wear compression stockings and there may be bruising associated with the procedure, it is advisable to schedule your procedure <u>several weeks prior to or after</u> special occasions and/or vacations that might be impacted by these factors.

Pre-Treatment Instructions: (before your treatment)

- You will be given a prescription in advance for Alprazolam and Lidocaine/Prilocaine cream.
 Follow the instructions given to you.
- You may eat a light breakfast or lunch prior to the procedure.
- Try to stay hydrated before the procedure.
- You should bring someone to drive you to and from the office.
- Please bring your compressions stockings with you.

Post-Treatment Instructions: (after your treatment)

You are under the influence of a sedative; you may not drive for 24 hours

- Go directly home after your procedure. You may walk every hour today but otherwise keep your leg elevated (on a stool or couch). Wear your compression stocking or Ace wrap and do not remove it until tomorrow morning.
- Take your compression stocking or Ace wrap off the morning following your procedure.
 You can remove any gauze dressing but leave the Steri-strips in place. You may shower.
- Place your stocking back on and wear it daily for one <u>week</u>. You should not sleep in your stocking after the first 24 hours.
- Follow-up within three days for your post procedure ultrasound.
- No heavy exercise until after ultrasound. You may walk briskly. No weights or running until after the ultrasound.
- Refrain from flying for two weeks after the procedure.
- No hot tub or whirlpool for one week after the procedure.

Please call your provider if you develop any redness, swelling, pain or shortness of breath.
