Your Pharmacy Shopping List:

- ☐ 100mg tablets of Colace. Starting TODAY take 2 Colace 100mg tabs by mouth daily in the mornings until the day of your procedure.
- ☐ 119 g bottle of Miralax—Mix one capful of Miralax info 8oz water every night until the day before your procedure and drink.
- ☐ Prescription for the Golytely.


- ☐ Purchase clear liquid products examples include:
 - sports drinks (not red, blue or purple). Diabetic patients are recommended to purchase a sugar-free version.
 - apple or white grape juice
 - ginger ale
 - clear broth or bouillon
 - water
 - coffee/tea without milk
 - clear carbonated beverages
 - plain Jell-O (not red, blue or purple and no fruit or toppings)
 - Italian ice
