	Patients on Blood Thinners: YOU MUST check in with your prescribing physician before stopping your medication. If you are currently taking an ASPIRIN daily, do not stop. Below is a list of common blood thinners and when, with physician approval, to discontinue them: • Ticlid (ticlopidine)—stop 10 days prior to procedure • Effient (prasugrel)—stop 7 days prior to procedure • Coumadin (warfarin), Plavix (clopidogrel) or Brilinta—stop 5 days prior • Pradaxa (dabigatron), Eliquis (apixaban) or Xarelto (rivaroxaban)—stop 48 hours prior	You will be fasting prior to your procedure.
